

# JAMES HARDIE WEATHERBOARDS

## MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

It is the responsibility of the specifier to determine normal maintenance requirements to comply with the New Zealand Building Code Acceptable Solution B2/AS1. The extent and nature of maintenance will depend on the geographical location and exposure of the building.

As a guide, it is recommended that basic normal maintenance tasks shall include but not be limited to:

- Washing down exterior surfaces every 6-12 months\*,
- Re-applying exterior protective finishes\*,
- Maintaining the exterior envelope and connections including joints, penetrations, flashings and sealants,
- Cleaning out gutters, blocked pipes and overflows as required,
- Pruning back vegetation close to or touching the building.
- The clearance between the bottom edge of the James Hardie Weatherboard and the finished ground must always be maintained.

*\* Refer to your paint manufacturer for washing down and recoating requirements related to paint performance.*
