Located 10 km southeast of Auckland city centre, Mount Wellington is known for the volcanic peak, Maungarei, "the watchful mountain" that rises above it. When designing a new Mount Wellington residence, Riverview Consultants specified James Hardie SecuraTM Interior Flooring, which much like Maungarei, is known for being strong and silent.

With Mount Wellington being a high growth area, partly due to its proximity to Sylvia Park Shopping Center and access to public transport, Lee designed this two-storey residence as a self-contained, double dwelling for separate tenancies on each floor.

A key driver in the selection of James Hardie flooring products was assurance of acoustic privacy between the individual dwellings. concrete with the speed of timber
installation. "The material is very solid,
you can feel the difference under your
feet," says Lee.
